06/04/10	Call Connect	In partnership with Lincolnshire County Council	Variable	Mondays to Saturdays	<p>The service will operate between 7am to 7pm. Concessionary bus passes can be used in the normal way. To use the Call Connect service, passengers must first become a member and this can be done in a simple phone call. Membership is free.</p> <p>The service can be used by passengers who do not have a direct, frequent bus service available to them. A passenger that lives in Ufford and wants to go to Queensgate can use Call Connect because there is no direct, frequent service available to them. However, a passenger that lives in Barnack and wants to go to Queensgate will not be able to use the service as a direct, frequency service (Delaine 201) is available to them.</p> <p>The service operates in response to prebooked requests. Passengers must book their journey at least 1 hour before they wish to travel. Passengers state the bus stop at which they would like to be collected, their destination and preferred travel time. The journey is then confirmed and all the passenger has to do is make their way to the bus stop at the designated time.</p>
